MARRIAGE & FAMILY, PART 2

Building a Godly Marriage

- 1. What direction did God give for marriage and family? (Genesis 1:27-28, 2:24)
- 2. What type of person does God want for us as we seek a marriage partner? (Proverbs 12:4, 18:22, 19:14, 31:10-31, Psalm 112:1-9)
- **3**. Ephesians 5:22-33 is perhaps the most comprehensive passage of scripture describing the marriage roles. What does it tell us about our commitment in marriage?
- 4. How do the following scriptures add to our understanding of our frame of mind in marriage? (Genesis 2:18, 1 Corinthians 11:3, Colossians 3:16-19, 1 Peter 3:1-7, 1 John 4:20)

- 5. What level of oneness does God want for our marriage? Why does God instruct us not to deprive one another? (Read 1 Corinthians 7:1-5 to answer questions 5-8)
- 6. What are the principles that we can apply to Christ and the church?

- **7**. How does God's instruction provide stability to the marriage as well as the whole family unit?
- 8. What happens when there fails to be an intimacy between the husband and wife?

Point to Ponder: Men, in what ways can you render affection to your wife? Women, in what ways can you give affection to your husband?

- **9**. How does the relationship described in Ezekiel 16:1-14 between the Lord and Israel relate to Christ and the church?
- 10. As described in Ezekiel 16:15-43, how did Israel repay the Lord for His goodness and love? How does 1 Corinthians 6:13-20 relate to the passage in Ezekiel?
- 11. We must maintain purity in our marriages. What warnings are given in Matthew 5:27-32 and James 1:13-15 to protect us from harming the marriage relationship?

12. What is the fruit of adultery in a marriage relationship? How does this affect the family unit?

Point to Ponder: It is interesting to note that in two of the Ten Commandments, purity in marriage is mentioned – the 7th commandment and the 10th commandment. Fidelity in marriage is so important to God!

13. What does adultery invariably lead to?

14. What is God's view of divorce? (Malachi 2:10-16)

15. What did Jesus communicate about the marriage commitment? (Matthew 19:3-9)

Points to Ponder: Notice the role that God plays in the marriage union by the words "What God has joined together..." In the same way, children are an inseparable union of a husband and wife, forever a reflection of two people creating one being. How awesome!

- 16. What was Paul's view of the importance of the marriage commitment? (1 Corinthians 7:10-16)
- 17. For what purpose does God instruct a believer to continue in a peaceful family relationship with an unbeliever? How does 1 Peter 3:1-2 relate to this passage in 1 Corinthians?

18. In what ways can our application of 1 Corinthians 13:4-8 improve and solidify our marriages?
