LESSON 4: FAITH TOWARD GOD

DAY 22

1. What is faith? (Hebrews 11:1)

P2P: Faith is the substance and the evidence of things not yet seen. Humanly, our lives are composed of things we accept by faith, things which are good (e.g. serving others is better than living selfishly) and things which are evil (e.g. doing whatever I want is what brings me lasting happiness).

 - a. What does it look like to have faith that pleases God?
 - b. What are the things we must believe to please God? Why do you think God declares it is impossible to please Him without this faith?
 - c. Have you stopped to consider how you cannot come to God if you don't have faith? Really consider the words of this verse. How vital is faith?

 - a. What happens when we live life without faith?

MEDITA	TE	Asking God for things in faith, and believing you will receive the things for which you ask, is essential to receiving them. Refer to Lesson 3, Question 15, to review God's promises to answer your prayers when you ask for anything according to His will, believing you will receive it.
PRAY		Thank God for giving you sufficient evidence to believe He exists. Believe that God will reward you for diligently seeking Him. Praise God for recording the story of the Israelites and the outcome of their lack of faith. Ask God to strengthen your faith so you can believe you will receive the things you request of Him.

P2P: Do you truly believe in Jesus and that what He did applies to you personally?

- b. If faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God, how vital is hearing God's word to you? Do you believe that God's word will grow your faith toward Him?
- 10. Read Galatians 2:20. How does living by faith manifest itself in our lives?

P2P: How do we crucify ourselves and live by the faith of the Son of God in our daily lives? What does that look like?

- 11. Read James 2:14-26 to answer the following questions.
 - a. What is the relationship between faith and works?

P2P: What is the difference between the faith of demons, who believe God exists, and the faith of God's children, who believe to the saving of the soul? How do the works of demons and saints differ as a result? What do you see in your own life?

P2P: Ultimately, all your works spring from what you believe. Whatever you believe and trust in the most will direct your actions.

12. Read 1 John 5:1-5. What attribute allows us to overcome the world? (1 John 5:1-5)

P2P: In what ways does this manifest itself in your life?

PRAY

Praise and glorify God for giving us the gospel message so you can be saved and have faith in Him! Thank God for His Word so your faith can be strengthened. Ask the Father to help you be crucified with Jesus Christ and not obey the lusts of the flesh. Offer yourself in service to Him to perform good works by faith.

DAY 25

13. What specifically do you need to know and believe about God? (1 John 4:13-16)

P2P: Do you know and believe the love that God has for you and for all His people? What does it mean to believe the love that God has for you? How does this change your approach to life?

MEDITATE

Read and meditate on Proverbs 3:5-10. Trusting God is an essential part of having faith toward God. Do you believe that His ways are perfect and right, even better than your own? Do you trust God enough to lay down what you think, your own opinions about what is right, to embrace what He teaches is right? It is critical for you to know and believe that what God teaches us is born out of His love for you and out of His perfect wisdom and understanding.

In our questions of faith, believing in God's love means we believe He cares about us in all things, at all times. We trust and believe in His perfect love. We believe first that He exists and that He rewards those who seek Him. We believe that He sent His Son to die for us. When we do so, we believe that He forgives all our sins and cleanses us from all unrighteousness. We then believe that He makes us just in His sight and that He imputes His very righteousness unto us. We then live by that faith, turning from our sinful ways and turning to God, to have faith toward Him.

Do you believe that God truly cares for you? Do you believe that God will never leave you or forsake you? Do you believe that God will always do what is best and right for you? Can you, in faith, say, "God, I love you and I know and believe that You love me. God, I am committed to You and I know and believe You are committed to me. God, in faith I do what is right and I know and believe that You always do what is right."

Living by faith is putting away all that is of your own life, wisdom and counsel, in order to live by the promises of God, and according to His counsel, will and commands.

PRAY

Praise God for being the perfect embodiment of love. Thank Him for all the things He does for you in your life. Review a few specific promises of God and claim them in prayer before Him. Commit to honoring God in all aspects of your life.

MEDITATE

Having faith toward God begins with a very simple belief that God exists and that He rewards those who diligently seek Him. Our very faith is demonstrated in this belief by living as if God exists and seeking Him throughout our life. Our faith is based on His promises, beginning with salvation through His Son Jesus. It continues by believing that we are forgiven of our sins and that we are made righteous by our faith in Him.

Having believed in His promises, we continue in faith, living according to our new standing in Him, as His children. We turn away from our own ways and turn ourselves fully toward God, believing and trusting in His perfect will,

knowing that He cares for us. It is by faith that we overcome the world and do the works of God.

God loves us and wants us to live by faith in Him. It is by faith that we do all things, believing and trusting in our God and Savior. Faith is an elementary principle of Christ. Without it, we are incapable of pleasing God and having any type of lasting relationship with Him.

PRAY

Take time to praise God for listening to your prayers, even when you continue to ask Him for some things repeatedly. Trust in His perfect will for you. Ask God to further build your faith in Him through the circumstances he allows in your life. Thank God for applying the righteousness of Jesus Christ to you so you can live by faith!

DAY 28

MEDITATE & PRAY

Spend time further reflecting upon and praying about the parts of Lesson 4 that really inspired you. Reflect on the fact that faith is essential to have a relationship with God.
